

What have we been learning about this week?

Nursery

In English we have been listening to alliteration and distinguishing between the sounds, s, a, and t.

In Maths we have been using big floor shapes to make pictures from 'The Leaf Man' story.

Our big question this week was 'What pictures can we see in 'The Leaf Man' story?' We found out that we could see ducks, chickens, a squirrel and fish.

Reception

In English we have been writing a letter to Mr Bear and learning about the postal service.

In Maths we have been identifying 2D shapes and describing their properties.

Our big question this week was 'How do our letters get delivered?' We found out that they are collected daily from the post box, taken to the post office and then distributed by post men and women using a variety of transport.
