## Next Week in English

### Year 3

Next week in Year 3, we will be learning a non-fiction discussion text linked to our fiction text of The Tunnel. We will be looking in particular at using conjunctions to extend our sentences.

### Year 4

Year 4 will be publishing our warning story this week and will then be moving on to learning to write a discussion text. We will learn how to articulate and justify answers, arguments and opinions.

### Year 5

Year 5 have written some amazing suspense stories this week. Next week we are going to begin to analyse and learn an explanation text.

### Year 6

Next week in Year 6, we will be finishing our stories before progressing onto looking at writing instructions. We will be thinking about using imperative verbs and our sentences structures.

## Next Week in Maths

### Year 3

Next week in maths, Year 4 will be looking at whether sums are commutative and then use fact families and the inverse operation to solve missing number problems.

### Year 4

Year 4 will be learning that counting up in multiples is also repeated addition. We will extend our counting in multiples knowledge to 25s. We will learn the distributive law by creating and regrouping arrays for multiplication and developing recall by learning multiplication facts through building arrays.

### Year 5

Next week in Year 5 we will be continuing our investigations of prime and composite number and using known facts to multiply and divide mentally.

### Year 6

Year 6 are continuing to learn how to simplify fractions to find their equivalents in preparation for learning how to compare and order fractions.
