PE planning programme	Increased three way differentiation of planning, which extends most able children, whilst also supporting and aiding lower attaining children. Extensions are provided for gifted and talented children. Improved staff knowledge and confidence.
Professional development Continual professional development offered to all staff through the Calderdale Sports Programme which included gymnastics and dance.	Standards of teaching and learning enhanced, with teachers being up-skilled in how to greater differentiate PE lessons and how to challenge gifted and talented children. Evidenced in planning scrutiny, with greater links made to curriculum 14 and lessons exhibiting greater personalisation.
Hiring specialist PE teachers and coaches	Staff provided with training and guidance. Children encouraged to take part in a range of sports, which has led to more children being entered into sporting competitions. An improvement in children's confidence and involvement in team sport.
