Child safety is a very important issue to us all here at Seymour Hill Primary School. Under no circumstances can parents bring cars into the car park to drop off or turn. At all times please do not walk your child through the school car park or use the car park gate to access the school. This also relates to parents and children walking from pre-school through to the main school as small children cannot be seen by drivers. This gate is for vehicular access only. A big thank you to all those parents who support the school by encouraging children to use the pedestrian access gates when entering or leaving the school grounds.

Also please park thoughtfully when dropping off or picking-up children. Residents in Hazel Avenue are experiencing difficulty with getting in and out of their houses.

Children may enter the playground from 8.45 am when a member of teaching staff is on duty.

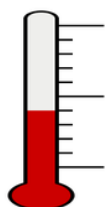


Congratulation to Seymour Hill Primary School who have earned their Silver Award for being an ECO School. The children are now working towards their Green Flag Award.
