



Declaration of Disqualification “by association”

The Department for Education (DfE) have advised of new laws regarding staff and governors who will be either working or managing provision for children aged 8 or under.

Disqualification “by association” is where an employee / governor is living in the same household where another person who is disqualified* lives or works.

***disqualification** means where the person is either on the Children’s Barred List, or has one of the wider disqualification criteria of:

- being cautioned for (within the last 6 years) or convicted of certain violent and sexual criminal offences against children and adults;
- grounds relating to the care of children (including where an order is made in respect of a child under the person’s care);
- having registration refused or cancelled in relation to childcare or children’s homes or being disqualified from private fostering;
