She is an experienced supply teacher.

We would also like to take the opportunity to thank Mrs Cunningham for all of her hard work over the past 16 years at Shelley First school and we wish her lots of luck in her new role. Mrs Hussain will be taking over the teaching role, 4 days per week for Class Lowry, with Mrs McGenity our SEND coordinator teaching for 1 day per week. Mrs Hussain is an experienced supply teacher.
