Average Scaled Scores – a pupil's scaled score is based on their raw score, which is the total number of marks a pupil scores in a test based on the number of questions answered correctly. The raw score is converted into a scaled score: the Average Scaled Score is calculated to reflect the performance of the cohort as a whole.

Progress – pupils' individual progress scores are calculated in comparison to other pupils nationally. A school's progress scores for reading, writing and maths are calculated as its pupils' average progress scores, which means that school level progress scores will be presented as positive and negative numbers either side of zero.
