With the countdown to Christmas well underway in school, I would like to keep you informed of arrangements for the next two weeks.

## Christmas Production

The first performance of 'The Magical Christmas Jigsaw' is at 2pm on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> December, in school time. For the second performance, which begins at 6.00pm on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> December, pupils should arrive at school between 5.30pm and 5.40pm). Pupils in Class 1 should arrive through the outdoor entrance to Class 1 and pupils in Class 2 should arrive through the outdoor entrance to Class 2. Parents/carers then sign in at the Main Entrance. Please remember that no photography is permitted: the school will take pictures and pass these on to parents via pupils. A collection will take place to help to support the cost of the performance. The Friends of School have a hamper raffle for both productions. Tickets are available through the school office.

## Christmas Party
