1. **CHRISTMAS CONCERT ~ 'SUPER STAR'**. The **whole school** will be performing 'Super star'.

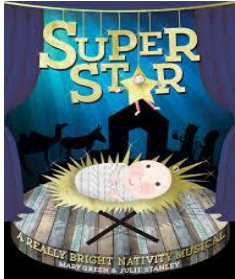

Aspen	Stars (the named stars can be creative with their costumes e.g. football 'star')

6. **RECEPTION 2018.** We are now offering individual tours for anyone looking for a school place for September 2018, please call the school office to arrange a visit before the deadline of 15th January 2018.
7. **PARKING AGAIN!** Please help us to keep our **children safe** by ensuring that families do not attempt to park in the School/Lympsham Green MCC/Children's Centre car parks between 8:30am and 9.00am and 3.00pm to 3.30pm. Gates will be shut during these times. The Sainsbury's staff car park can be used if families need to drive to pick up and drop off. Any exceptions are only for Blue Badge holders and families with children with specific individual needs. Thank you for your cooperation.
8. We have been asked to pass on the following information from **Public Health England** regarding **norovirus** (also known as 'winter vomiting bug') which has been reported in the Bath area. **Anyone with symptoms of norovirus should:**
- Stay away from work or school until they have been **free of symptoms for at least 48 hours** and avoid contact with others where possible.
 - Keep hydrated by drinking fluids as tolerated.
 - If symptoms persist (more than 48 hours), phone the GP or the NHS non-emergency number 111 for advice.
 - Encourage thorough and regular hand washing with soap and water but particularly after toilet visits and before eating and handling food. **Alcohol hand gel is not effective against norovirus.**
 - Do not visit friends or relatives in hospital or residential care homes as there is a real risk of introducing the infection to the establishment.
 - Do not handle or prepare food for other people until symptom free for at least 48 hours.
