## Next Week in English

### Year 3

Next week in English, Year 3 will be planning and writing a discussion text linked to their work in geography.

### Year 4

Year 4 are continuing to learn how to articulate and justify answers, arguments and opinions. They are innovating a discussion text and will then move on to inventing their own. They will be presenting these to the class.

### Year 5

Next week, Year 5 are going to be writing an explanation text about an alien species. We are looking forward to learning their life cycles.

### Year 6

Next week in Year 6, we will be writing our own instructions for a potion the children have created. We will be using our instruction toolkits to help us structure these effectively. We will be using imperative verbs, parallel instructions and technical language.

## Next Week in Maths

### Year 3

Next week we will be learning formal written method for addition. This will lead to regrouping of ones and tens.

### Year 4

Year 4 will be rehearsing and recalling multiplication facts; making links and spotting patterns. They will be learning the laws of divisibility to help with division facts and learn to use strategies for calculating multiplication facts.

### Year 5

We will be solving problems involving the knowledge of key facts

### Year 6

Next week in maths, the children will be learning how to compare and order fractions, including fractions greater than 1, either by finding a common denominator or estimation.
