Dear Parents/Carers,

Christmas in Verse

This year we will be telling the story of Christmas through poetry.

There will be three performances: one in the afternoon for parents/families with pre-school children and babies and an evening and a morning performance for adults and older children only. **Please do not bring young children or babies to the evening or morning performances.**

We currently have 101 families in the school, but our Fire Assessment only allows us to offer 127 seats per performance. Therefore, initially we can only offer 1 ticket per family for the evening. We can offer 2 per family for either of the daytime performances. Spare tickets will be allocated through a lucky dip system in order to be fair to everyone.

With our numbers increasing year on year we are only inviting the governors and community helpers to come along to our daytime performance in order to free up as many evening performance tickets as possible. Next year we will review whether to put on two evening performances if our numbers continue to grow as they have.

Tickets will cost £1.00 per ticket and to purchase them please send in a named envelope with the money and indicate which performance you would like (either print off the reply slip or write clearly on a piece of paper). We are not numbering the seats this year; seating will be on a first come basis and your ticket is also your raffle ticket. You only need to return one slip per family, not per child.

This year our Pupil Leaders have chosen **Physlis Tuckwell** as the charity we will give all raffle monies to.

If your child needs an outfit or to wear particular clothes, the class teacher will let you know. We are sure you will enjoy the production; the children are enjoying the carols we've begun to practise!
