Pupil Premium Funding

All pupils in Reception to Year 2 receive a school meal at no cost to parents. However if as a parent you are in receipt of benefits such as Income Support, Income Based Job Seekers Allowance, Income-related Support Allowance, Support under Part VI of the Immigration & Asylum Act 1999, Universal Credit or Child Tax Credit (but are not entitled to a Working Tax Credit) and whose annual income (as assessed by HMRC) does not exceed £16,190, then your child may well be entitled to a statutory entitlement to a free school meals and our school can claim Pupil Premium funding to be spent on music lessons, extra curricular clubs and school trips etc.

Please register even if your child is in Reception, Y1 or Y2.
