Dear Parent,

Complaints have been received about inconsiderate parking on School Lane, Haugh Avenue and surrounding streets.

If you use your car to take and fetch your children from school please ensure that you park considerately. Please do not park across residents' driveways, gateways, on the corners of Whalley Road or on private land.

Parking inconsiderately causes difficulties and distress for local residents and in addition may cause obstruction and congestion which can compromise the safety of the children who walk to school.

When parking on the streets nearby please be aware that pedestrians need room to walk on the pavement with children and pushchairs etc. As a general rule please leave at least enough room on the pavement (not the grass verge) for a parent with a double buggy to pass safely. **Pedestrians should NEVER have to walk out into the road to negotiate a parked vehicle.**

Can I also remind parents that there is **NO STOPPING on the zig zags** – they cannot be used as a pick up or drop off point

Please be aware that the drivers of cars parked inconsiderately may incur a penalty for obstruction. Thank you for your co-operation.
