WEEKLY ACTIVITIES	Reading: at least three times a week.	Spellings: learn your weekly spellings.	Complete the weekly home learning tasks set by Mr Richards.
TERMLY ACTIVITIES	<u>Food journey map</u> Investigate some food packaging in your home. Where has the food come from? Create a map to show the origins of the food in your kitchen. You could use a website such as www.foodmiles.com to add the distances your foods have travelled.		<u>Pet portrait</u> This term in art & design our focus will be using animals as our subjects for drawing and painting. Your task is to use your art skills to produce a portrait of your pet (or a pet you would like to own!)
	<u>Nutrition detective</u> Make an eye-catching poster to show a favourite meal and which of the seven nutrition groups (proteins, fats, carbohydrates, vitamins, minerals, fibre and water) it provides. Use your science learning to include details of what happens to each nutrient inside your body and/or how it is good for you.	<u>Staying safe online</u> Create a poster or video in which you give advice on how to stay safe when using the internet. You could focus on gaming, videos or searching for and using websites. Make your message clear – imagine you are making it for a child younger than yourself – and interesting for your audience.	

TOP TIP! Most of these projects may take a while or a few goes before they are finished. That's normal. Plan out what you want to do before you start and chat through your ideas with someone else. Take your time. Redraft or remake if you need to. Produce your best work and have fun!
