Important Free School Meal Information

It has come to our attention that some families are confused as to whether they are entitled to Free School Meals. The school is given strict guidelines to follow. You are entitled if you receive the below:

- Income Support
- Income based jobseekers allowance
- Support under Part VI of the immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit (provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross household income of no more than £16,190)
- The guaranteed element of state pension credit
- Income related employment and support allowance
- Working Tax Credit run on – paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for working tax credits.

You are not entitled to Free School Meals if you receive Working Tax Credits.

Failure to notify the School of any changes to your benefit may mean you have to pay for any meals taken whilst you were not eligible.

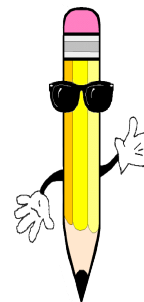
