Reverend White has asked me to pass on the total of the Christingle collections. We raised £180.70 – a fantastic amount for The Children's Society, so thank you for your contributions. We have also received a lovely card from Paragon Service Point (St George's Crypt) to thank Reception and KS1 for the £156.15 raised from their Christmas Nativity.

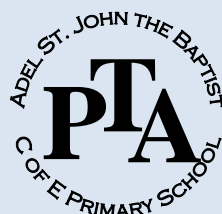
