Mr Atkins' class have been learning about money. They were able to find different coins to represent different amounts.

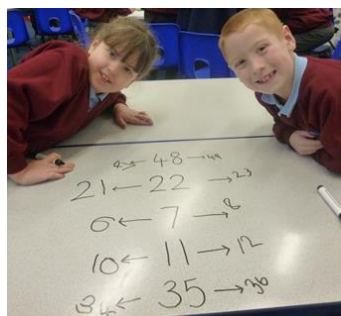


In Miss Dowling's class the children have been learning how
