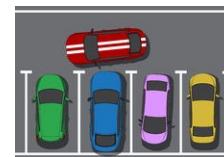

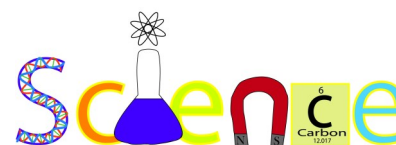
### **YEAR 2 CARBON MONOXIDE AWARENESS DAY - WEDNESDAY 17th JANUARY 2018**
