A Year 6 report on the visit to the Holocaust Centre

'On Tuesday, year 6 went to the Holocaust Centre near Newark. When we arrived we went through the memorial gardens into a classroom where the staff explained our exciting day. After that, we discovered what life was like for a Jewish child during World War 2. We explored an interactive museum where we learnt the difficulties they faced such as being under constant threat of physical and mental abuse. Their businesses were destroyed and we discovered how some Jewish children left the country to live in Britain via Kinder Transport. We were deeply saddened to learn that 6000000 Jewish people were killed during WW2 and we placed a rock on a sculpture in memory of one child each. After lunch, we met a Jewish survivor of World War 2 - Bernard- who had escaped from Berlin. His harrowing tale was shocking and sad- but interesting and we feel lucky to have met him.'
