We will be studying the history of Britain through the Anglo Saxon period.

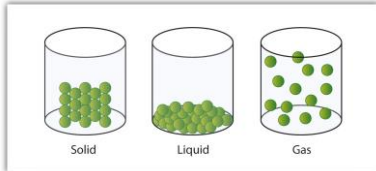

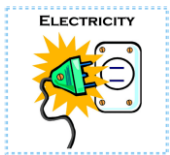
We will be finding out about 'Going for Goals'.

Compare and group materials in to solids, liquids and gasses, observe changing states including evaporation and condensation.

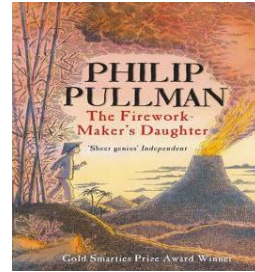


Identify common appliances that run on electricity. Construct simple electrical circuits, switches and conductors and insulators.
