ESSENTIAL

Packed lunch for the first day
Waterproof kagoule or anorak
Wellington boots
3 sets of underclothes and socks
Pyjamas
Wash things and wash bag (toothpaste, brush/comb, etc. ... NO SPRAYS e.g. roll on deodorant instead)
2 towels
2 warm jumpers or sweatshirts
3 T-shirts (including one old one which could get dirty)
2 pairs of jogging bottoms or trousers (NO JEANS!)
Thick socks for walking (NOT NYLON FOOTBALL SOCKS.. They cause blisters)
Indoor footwear e.g. trainers, pumps or slippers
Woollen hat or cap
Pair of gloves
2 black sacks for dirty or wet clothes
Sleeping Bag and Pillow

DESIRABLE BUT NOT ESSENTIAL

Waterproof trousers
Walking Boots
Large ruck sack for carrying kit
Disposable camera
