Who is this meeting for, and why?

- All parents of children in Year 2.
- To provide you with information about SATs.
- To help you help prepare your child for SATs.

What are SATs and why do children take them?

Statutory Assessment Tests

End of key stage measure of attainment (expected standard or above) and pupil progress.

What are children tested on?

English:

- Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling test – optional
- Paper 1 reading
- Paper 2 reading

Mathematics:

- Paper 1 test (arithmetic)
- Paper 2 test (reasoning)

English Tests

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling Test (optional):

- Paper 1 – spelling test with 20 spellings (approximately 15 minutes)
- Paper 2 – short answer questions covering grammar, punctuation and vocabulary (approximately 20 minutes)

English Tests

Reading Tests:

- Paper 1 – reading prompt and answer booklet.
- Paper 2 – more challenging texts. Answer booklet and a separate reading booklet.

Mathematics Tests

- Paper 1 – arithmetic test – single test paper.
- Paper 2 – reasoning test – linked to solving problems and reasoning mathematically.

The tests will take place in May and the results will be used as part of the overall assessment for your child.

What can **YOU** do to help your child?

Make sure your child:


- Gets LOTS of sleep each night – aim to have your child in bed, and asleep, by 8.30pm.
- Has a balanced diet – not too much sugar!
- Comes to school EVERY day, and on time (doors open at 08:45).
- Is supported with their homework – reading, phonics, mathematics.
