## DIRECTOR OF THE WEEK



**Dr Huw Morgan**

Hello, My name is Huw Morgan, and I've been a Director at Broughton for about 2 years. We've lived in Cumbria for nearly 27 years now, having been in Preston before that, although my roots are in North Wales, as you might guess from the name. Neither of our two boys attended Broughton since we live in Papcastle, but both were taught by Mrs Shankland in her previous life at Bridekirk, and since my wife Jane has volunteered in the Year 2 class (with Mrs Wilson and now with Miss Robinson) for over 7 years, I feel I know the school pretty well. Before I retired three years ago, I'd worked in the nuclear industry for 37 years, originally as technical researcher, but in later years in resource management and commercial roles. In my last 10 years I was Strategy Director for the Government-owned National Nuclear Laboratory, based at Sellafield, a job which took me to countries all over the globe.
