Chicken Pox

I would like to make parents aware that we have had 3 reported cases of Chicken Pox since the start of the term.

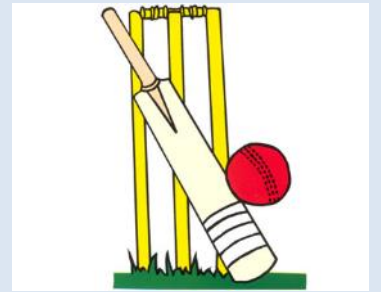
