



SEN Teaching Assistant Level 1

The successful applicant will support the pupil to integrate into their new school, reducing their level of anxiety. This will include one to one work, small group work and supporting the child in the classroom environment, alongside his peers, to develop his social, emotional and mental health, communication and social interaction skills, attention and concentration skills and his literacy and mathematical skills.

The successful applicant needs to have some proven experience of working successfully with children who present with challenging behaviour. They will:

- be calm and patient
- be firm but fair
- be a team player
- have a friendly approach
- have a good knowledge of child development
- have proven experience of building children's self-esteem and basic skills
- have a good sense of humour
- be able to work on own initiative as well as part of a team
- be able to keep objective and accurate records
- have good communication skills
- be able to independently adapt planned learning to suit the needs of the child
- be able to demonstrate commitment to our positive school ethos.
