

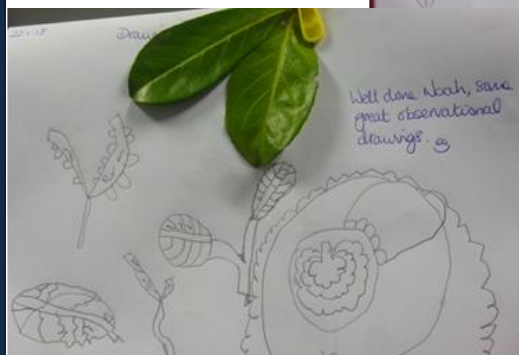
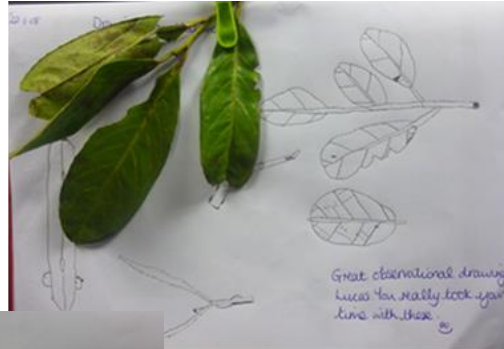

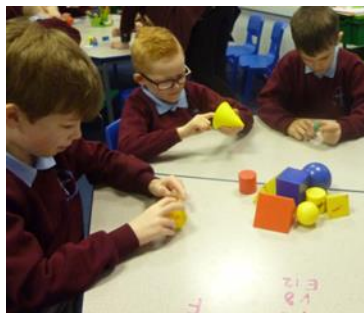


Our year one and two children have been working hard on their observational drawings this week.
