During February we would like all children to take part in our Reading Challenge.

Listening to your child read at home makes a huge difference to their progress in literacy at school. Even if your child is a fluent reader it is still important to listen to them read

Read for at least 10 minutes a day for five days a week to get a reward:

Read for 5 days

BRONZE READING CERTIFICATE

Read for 10 days

SILVER READING CERTIFICATE

Read for 15 days

GOLD READING CERTIFICATE

Read for 20 days

OUTSTANDING READING AWARD

Fill in the attached reading sheet and bring into school every Thursday so that certificates can be awarded.

On World book day on Thursday 1st March we will put all the children who have received the Outstanding Reading Award into a special draw to win one of six prizes (two per year group).

Reading with your child is one of the best ways to develop their literacy skills and we are hoping that this challenge will make a big difference to the children's reading in school.
