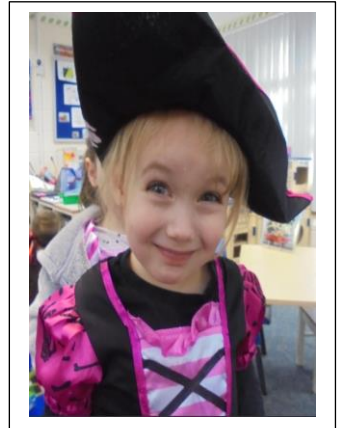
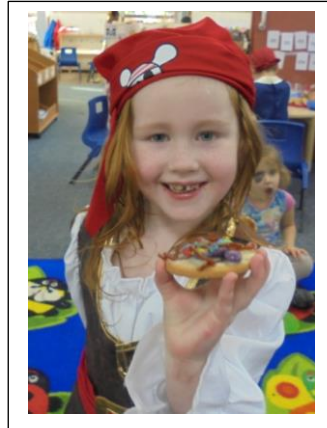


School Dinners
