- Ancient Greek myths and legends:
Our first unit of study will lead us to explore a myth set in the Ancient Greek times; the story of Theseus and the Minotaur. We will think about how myths and legends are composed and why they have been written, before creating our own.
- Reports:

Theme

The Ancient Greeks

We will be travelling back in time to study various aspects of Ancient Greek life.

We will be thinking about what life would have been like as an Ancient Greek and how they have influenced life today. We will be studying different aspects of the Ancient Greek culture in depth including; religion, food and buildings.

As well as this, we are going to develop our geography skills by looking at the location and features of Greece. We will also use our artistic skills to design and create our own Parthenon.

We will be developing our computing and coding skills, providing a modern, up-to-date curriculum!

Science

Electricity

For the first of our science topics, we will look at electricity. We will learn about how to use electricity safely at home, as well as learn about the journey electricity makes to get to our homes. We will be investigating electrical conductors and creating our own circuits.

Science Investigation

As a part of our science learning, we will complete a class science investigation. This will involve us becoming scientists for a day and looking at states of matter and conducting fair tests.

Maths

Number

Timetables and division facts will continue to play an important part of our maths learning, along with basic numbers skills such as addition, subtraction and place value.

We will have a weekly multiplication test focusing on our application of our times tables.

Time

During the autumn term, we will be learning to tell the time on both an analogue and digital clock. We will be learning to read up to 5 minute intervals. Children will then apply their knowledge to real life time problems.

Where possible, we will link our Maths to our theme work or to real life to give the children a real understanding of how their learning will help them in life.

PSCHE

We will be focusing on developing our PSCHE skills, thinking about: - Giving – Connecting – Keeping active – Taking notice.
