**Children's Mental Health Week 5<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> February**

During Children's Mental Health week we will be encouraging the children and adults in school to celebrate their own uniqueness.

We will be explaining that having a positive view of ourselves helps us all cope with any life challenges that come our way. We will show that by recognising different qualities in each other this allows us to connect with everyone around us. Well-being is vital to us all. **Ask your child**
