Twitter



- Open the Twitter app.
- Select the profile picture
- Select "Settings and Privacy" then select "Privacy and Safety"
- Ensure that "Protect your Tweets" has been selected, this means that only followers can see this account's tweets.
- Ensure that photo tagging is off so that other users can't tag this account in photos.
- Unselect the box labelled "Receive messages from anyone" so that only approved users can send messages.
- Ensure the "Display media that may contain sensitive content" box is unchecked.
- Personalisation and Data should be off.
- To block an account go to the account, select the three vertical dots and then select block.
- To report a tweet, select the drop down arrow in the top right of the tweet and then select report tweet.
- Remind children not to share information such as name, address, date of birth, school, names of friends/family, e-mail addresses, passwords, including in their bio.
- Be aware of what information can be gleaned from photos/videos that are shared.
- Remind children to check that content is accurate before sharing - help them to work out what is really 'fake news.'
