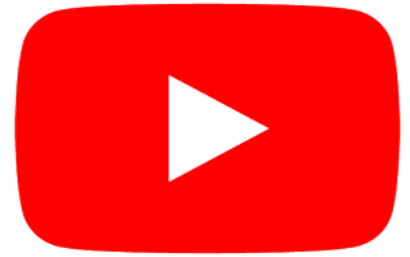

YouTube



- Open the YouTube app.
- Select the profile picture in the top-right corner.
- Select Settings, then General Settings.
- Here you can limit the mobile data usage, useful if you don't want to pay for extra data and also select "Only when on Wi-Fi" in "Uploads."
- Autoplay should be deselected so that your child can choose what to watch next, rather than have YouTube decide.
- Restricted Mode should be selected as this will filter some of the content available on the device it is selected on. This will need to be activated on all tablets/phones etc.
- On "Live chat" make sure 'Hold for Review' is selected enabling messages to be held for review.
- Back on the Account screen, select "My channel" then the 'gear' and ensure the Privacy settings are switched to blue. Here you can also check if your child has entered any person information in their description and alter it by selecting the 'pen'.
- Remind children not to share information such as name, address, date of birth, school, names of friends/family, e-mail addresses, passwords and be aware of what is visible in the background of their videos.
- To block a user, go onto their page, select the three vertical dots and then select block user.
- To report a video, once it is open, select the three vertical dots and then select report.
