Truthfulness

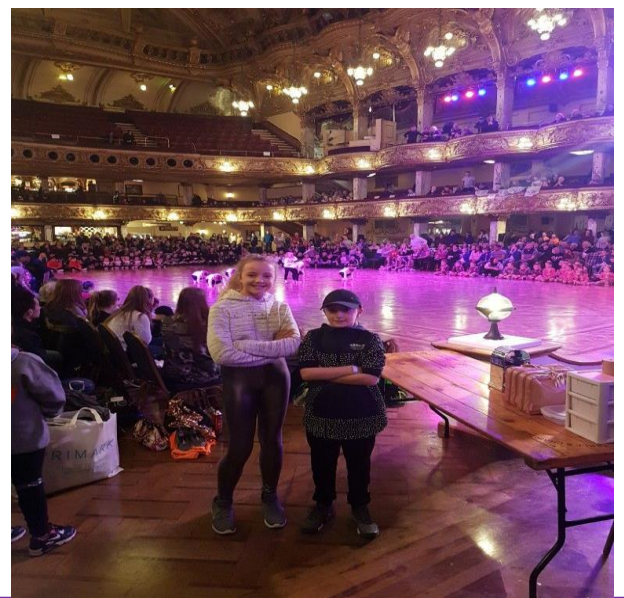
Our Christian Value for this half term is Truthfulness. Children who were recognised for being truthful last week are, Taylor, Year 3 and Joel in Year 1/2.
