After School Clubs

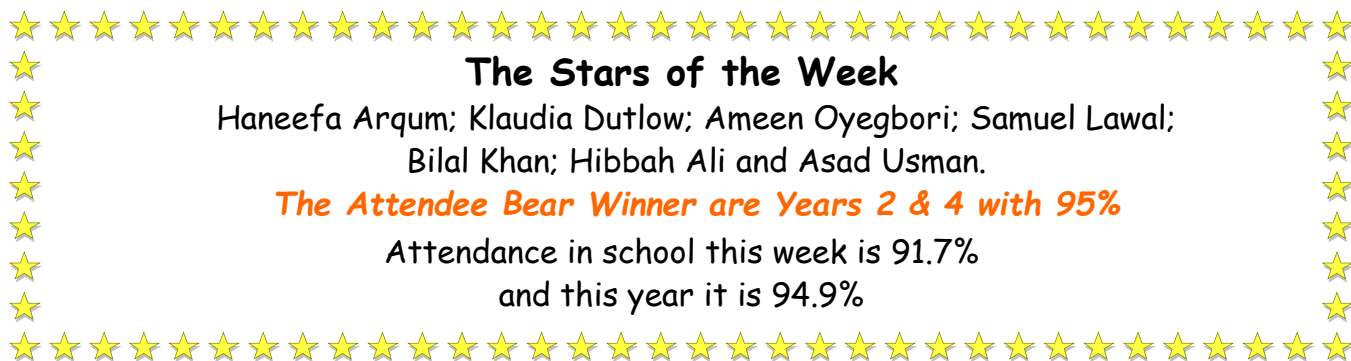

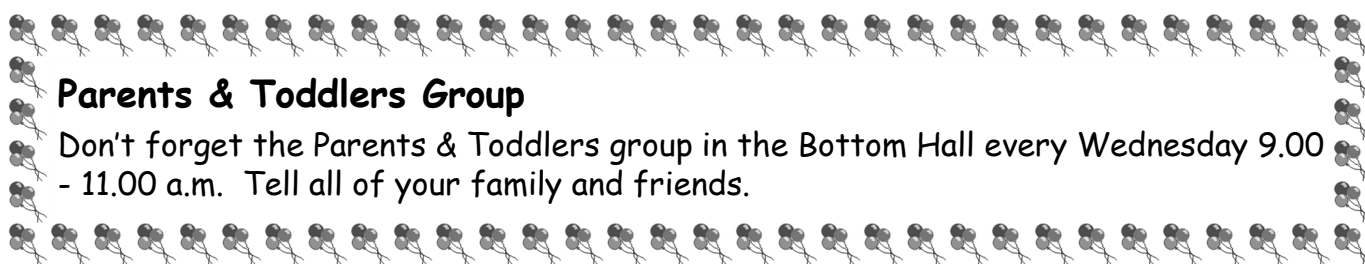
