Additional running can be done through Junior Park Run which is organised by an outside group of runners – www.parkrun.org.uk It is for children only on a Sunday at 9.00am and runs for 2km. It is free to register and is on every week. This is an excellent way for the children to get out there with other runners and run the distance.
