Reading

We aim to read individually with every child twice a week and once in a guided reading group.

Theme

Phonics

This half term the children will be learning phase 3 sounds these include; air, ure and er. We will also be learning about vowels and consonants and introducing 'consonant clusters'.

We will also look at some tricky words too—was, my, you, they, her, have, some and come.
