

Non-Uniform Day

Our School Council have been busy thinking about their fundraising target for the year ahead. They are still dedicated to raising funds for the Trim Trail we hope to buy later in the year and have suggested a dedicated fundraising campaign for a defibrillator that we can locate outside the school gates, on Borrowwash Road. Recently, staff at school received First Aid Training, including the use of a defibrillator. It became apparent to us all that there was no AED unit located this side of the A52, hence the proposal of a fundraising campaign to try and raise the £800 we need to buy a defibrillation unit.

We are absolutely overwhelmed by the generosity of our school and parent/carer community as a staggering £365 has been raised from your very kind and generous donations – thank you! I know the School Council are busy writing to local businesses in the locality to ask if they would like to contribute to our defib fund. Once again, a very big thank you to everyone!



Staying safe online

This week, the pupils in school have been learning how to keep safe when online. There have been special assemblies and all the children have been involved in activities in their own classes that raise awareness of keeping safe on line, when using the internet.

Staffing

We have said 'goodbye' to Miss Robinson, our catering supervisor this term. Miss Robinson has been part of the Asterdale team for several years and we wish her well as she embarks on new travelling adventures. We welcome Mrs Thomas as our new catering manager, commencing her post on Feb 26th 2018. Mrs Thomas has lots of exciting ideas for our lunchtime provision and is keen to work with the children in school to plan menus for the term ahead.

Dinner Money

Dinner money is charged at £11 per week or £2.20 per day and we appreciate payment either by cheque or cash every Monday morning and should be paid in advance. Payment for the whole term (until March 23rd 2018) can also be made at a cost of £44.00. Cheques should be payable to Derby City Council.

A reminder to all families in Reception, Y1 & Y2 that the Universal Infant Free School Meals programme is available, offering a hot meal at lunchtime at no cost to parents/carers. Any families in YR-6 who think they may be eligible to claim for Free School Meals, please ask in the school office or see the school website for more information. Children may also bring sandwiches to eat at lunchtime. We request that 2 weeks' notice is given to the office to make any changes to the usual lunchtime pattern.

May we respectfully remind all families that we will not let dinner money debt accumulate. We thank those families who make payment in advance of the school meal being taken. Families are provided with a note each week informing them of any outstanding debt and we value a prompt response in settling the debt. We will advise families if debt accumulates beyond two weeks and suggest that sandwiches are brought to school until the debt is cleared. Thank you for your help and support with dinner money payment.

Attendance – every day counts

Attendance and punctuality at school is monitored closely each week. We ask that parents/carers notify school by 9.10am each day if their child is likely to be absent and the reason for the absence. Voicemail messages can be left on the main office phone (01332 662323) or via the school email address (admin@asterdale.derby.sch.uk).

Could we remind all carers and parents that school is not able to authorise term time holidays, unless in exceptional circumstances. Any families who feel their request for a term time holiday meets exceptional circumstances, are politely requested to complete a 'Leave of Absence' form available from the office or the school website at least 2 weeks before the anticipated holiday.

Our current attendance data is checked and monitored each week by week. The Government target is 96% with Asterdale Primary School tracking at 94.7%.

Thank you for continuing to promote positive attendance.

Vacancies

We currently have two vacancies in school that are advertised on the Derby City Council recruitment pages. One is to join the midday supervisor team – working 5 days each week from 11.55-1.20pm during term time only and the second vacancy is as a catering assistant working in the school kitchen, from 10.30-1.30pm each day for 5 days each week. Again, this is a term time contract. Please enquire in the school office if you need further information.

We are always keen to add names of people who would be interested in being added to our 'relief' list for midday and catering support. Please see colleagues in the school office for more details.
