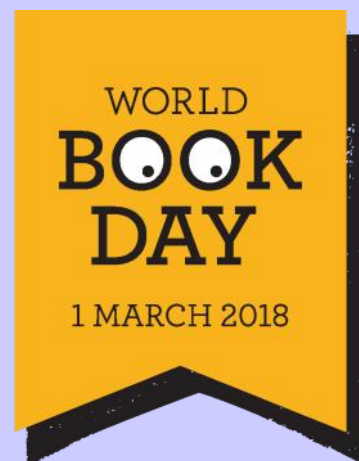

***World Book Day is next Thursday, 1st March, and we are celebrating in the following ways:***

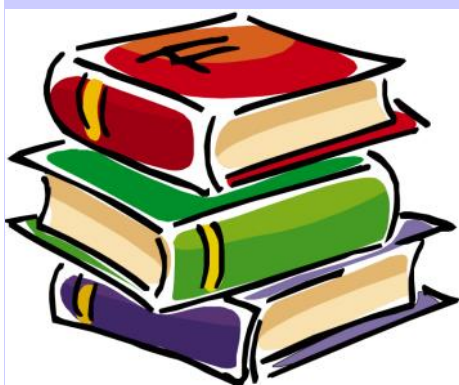
This year we are not asking the children to dress up, therefore normal school uniform applies. Throughout the day, the children will be taking part in World Book Day activities;

these include a 'Book Swap', shared reading sessions throughout school to share favourite books, and everyone taking part in competitions designed by our own librarians!



For the Book Swap, we ask that children bring in one or two books that they are happy to swap with another child. All of the books will be set out in the hall and the children will be given the opportunity to swap the books that they have brought with someone in their own class. Thank you everyone for the positive responses we have had so far to our new 'Homework Leaflets'! I hope the parents who came to the drop-in on Monday got all their questions answered.

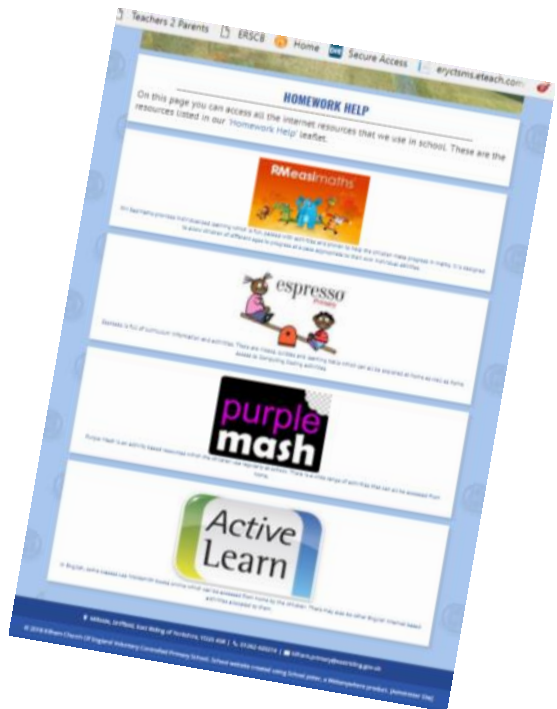
All Year 1 and Reception children have now been issued with a log-in for RM EasiMaths which will now be sent home - please look out for them.
