World Book Day

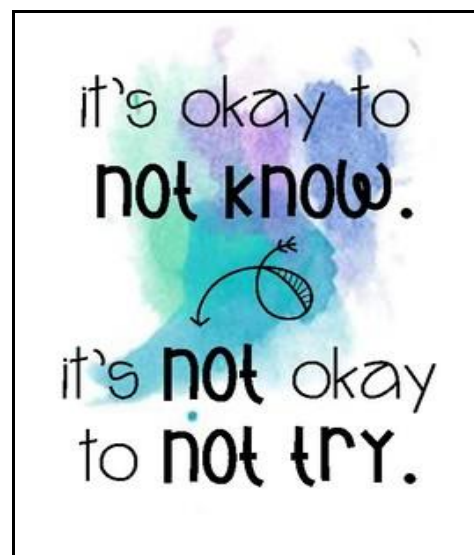

Levy


Thank you to those who have paid the £10 per family levy. We are still collecting and please remember that school has to pay for everyone who does not.
