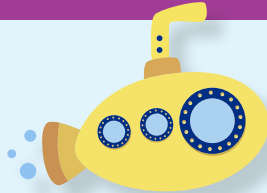

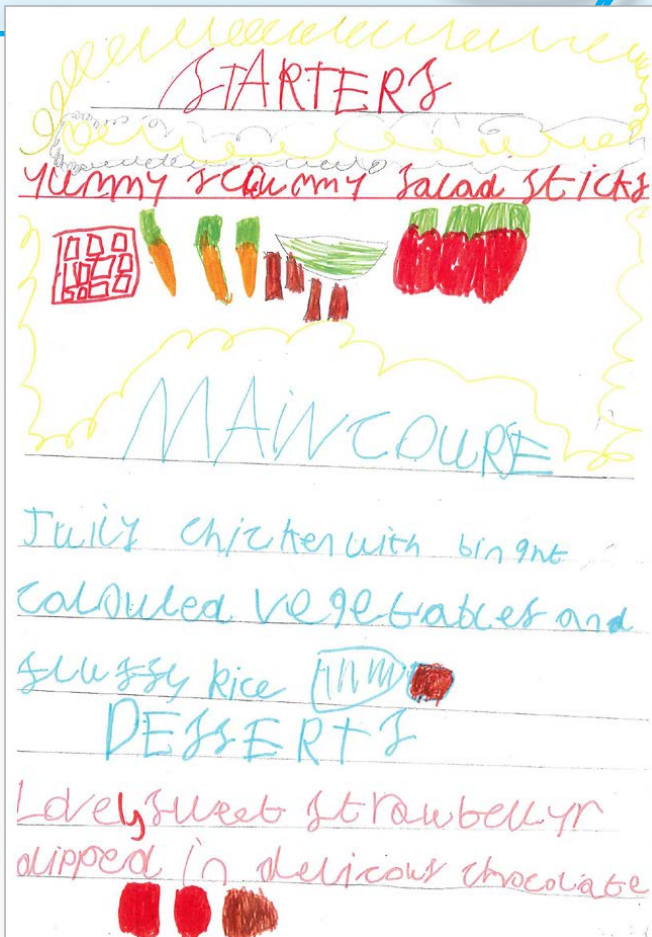
## Healthy Eating with Cedar Class Menus
