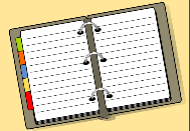
Welcome back to term 4

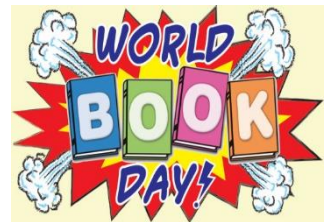
