Next Week in English

Year 3

Year 3 will be learning multiplication facts through visualising arrays. We will then look at division by sharing and grouping manipulatives and linking multiplication and division using arrays.

Year 4

Year 4 are learning their new story 'Adventure to Canbury Park' next week. They will be immersed in the text through drama roleplay and explore themes of suspense

Year 5

Year 5 will be continuing to learn their new story, Pandora's Box.
They will be exploring the elements of enticing opener and cliff-hanger endings and including them in their own work.

Year 6

Next week in English, we will be learning our new story map, which is based on a short story called 'Kidnapped!' Vocabulary and structure choices will be examined and we will be writing our own version of an action story.

Next Week in Maths

Year 3

Next week in English, Year 3 will be continuing to learn their new story and then reading the text, focusing particularly on action. We will also plan a new story.

Year 4

Next week, Year 4 will continue to learn about measures, focusing on time. They will be learning to convert time between analogue and digital 12 and 24 hours.

Year 5

Year 5 will be learning equivalent fractions. They will also be solving problems involving fractions

Year 6

Next week in maths, the children will be learning to find the perimeter and area of a variety of 2D shapes. We will also be solving problems involving perimeter and area.
