Reception Class

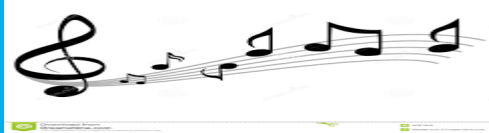


This week Reception class have had the pleasure of watching chicks hatch from their eggs. The children have been enthralled and have loved looking after the new chicks.
