#### DGAT

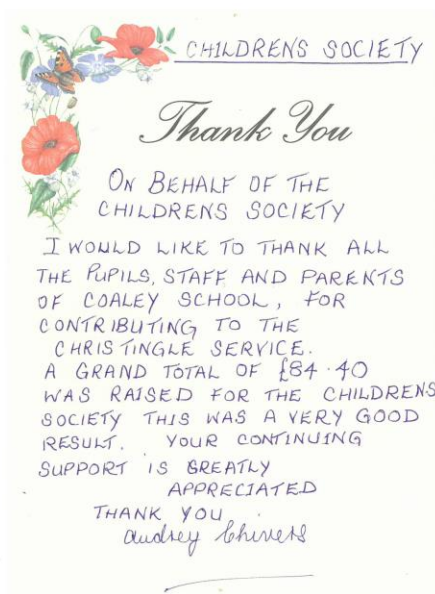

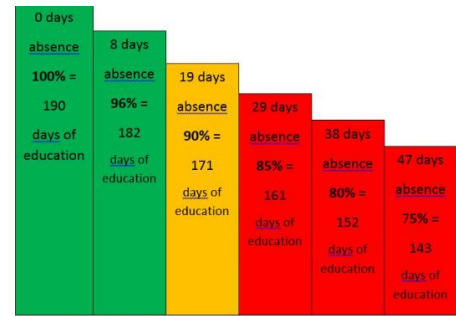


**Website**
