A snowy week!

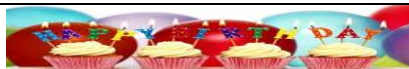

Ask your child

To help parents find out what is going on in school each week we will give a list of questions for parents to ask their children linked to lessons and activities from the week before. This week:

- Ask your **Reception Class Child** if they can tell you the story of *The Gruffalo*.
- Ask your **Year 1** child if they can tell you what plants we saw in the school grounds during Science.
- Ask your **Year 2** if they can tell you who 'Paul Klee' is.
- Ask your **Year 3** child to describe the structure of a human tooth.
- Ask your **Year 4** child why the River Nile was so important to Ancient Egyptians.
- Ask your **Year 5** child what is meant by a *Trade Surplus*, *Trade Deficit* and when a *Trade Embargo* would be used by a country.
