Your suggestions.....	Our response.....
Reading and writing club	We currently offer an ICT and a Sports club each week. We are looking at the clubs we offer so that there is a range of different activities over the year.
Maybe place a few more chairs at the back of the hall for when parents/ grandparents etc. come to watch performances	We appreciate that some performances can attract lots of people to watch. We currently put out all the adult chairs we own for performances. We have to allow space around the edge of the hall and at the back for health and safety reasons so unfortunately we are not able to put any more chairs out.
A more up to date method of informing parents of individual pupil progression	Everyone in school and nursery has an opportunity to meet with their child's teacher or key worker each term. Please ask if you would like to talk to your child's teacher or key worker at any other time - they will be more than happy to do this. We have looked in the past at email / internet based ways to share pupil progress. We prefer to meet face-to-face with parents so we can work together, discuss any concerns and celebrate your child's successes together.
Do more parent/child activities in school.	Hopefully everyone enjoyed the Science Activity afternoons in school during January. There are also regular Family Learning courses on offer. We are aiming to have at least one event every term but also understand that attending these can be tricky for working parents.
Coat hanger space. Gets crowded with Willow School, PT, coats and pack lunches	We are currently looking at the coat peg space and variety of bags children bring to school with them.
Parents receiving multiple copies of newsletters	We are looking at how we could manage this efficiently and ensure everyone is kept up to date.
