School Meals

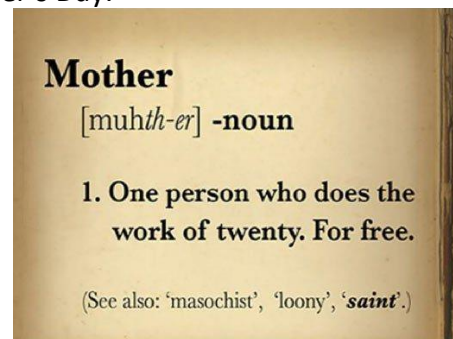
