## Energy Drink Restrictions

Morrisons have written to us to let us know about the restrictions being introduced on the sale of high-caffeine energy drinks. They have listened to parents and teachers who have raised concerns about the potential adverse impact of these drinks on children's behaviour.

In response, from Monday 5th March, they will ask customers buying high caffeine energy drinks (containing more than 150mg of caffeine per litre) to prove they are over 16 years of age.

These restrictions will apply to in store and online sales and will be implemented through our well established 'Challenge 25' age restricted controls. This means that any customer who looks under the age of 25 will be asked for proof of age when attempting to buy these products
