The governors have made the final decision on the school uniform for September 2018. The uniform will be supplied by Ziggys, Albion Road Halifax, . Parents will be able to buy direct from the shop

The new uniform will be:-

- V-necked Maroon Sweatshirt
- Formal White shirt
- Maroon/white striped tie
- Grey trousers/skirt/pinafore
- Grey tights or socks
- Black shoes
- Summer Dress will be red checked.

Parents have expressed a strong preference for keeping the old logo which we have taken on board. The PE kit will remain the same with the four house colours and the coloured logo. The logo on the new uniform will remain the same but with a variation of shades of grey.

We will not be placing any more orders now with the current provider as we are hoping, that with the help of FOCSA, we can see parents through to the end of term by recycling the current blue uniform.
