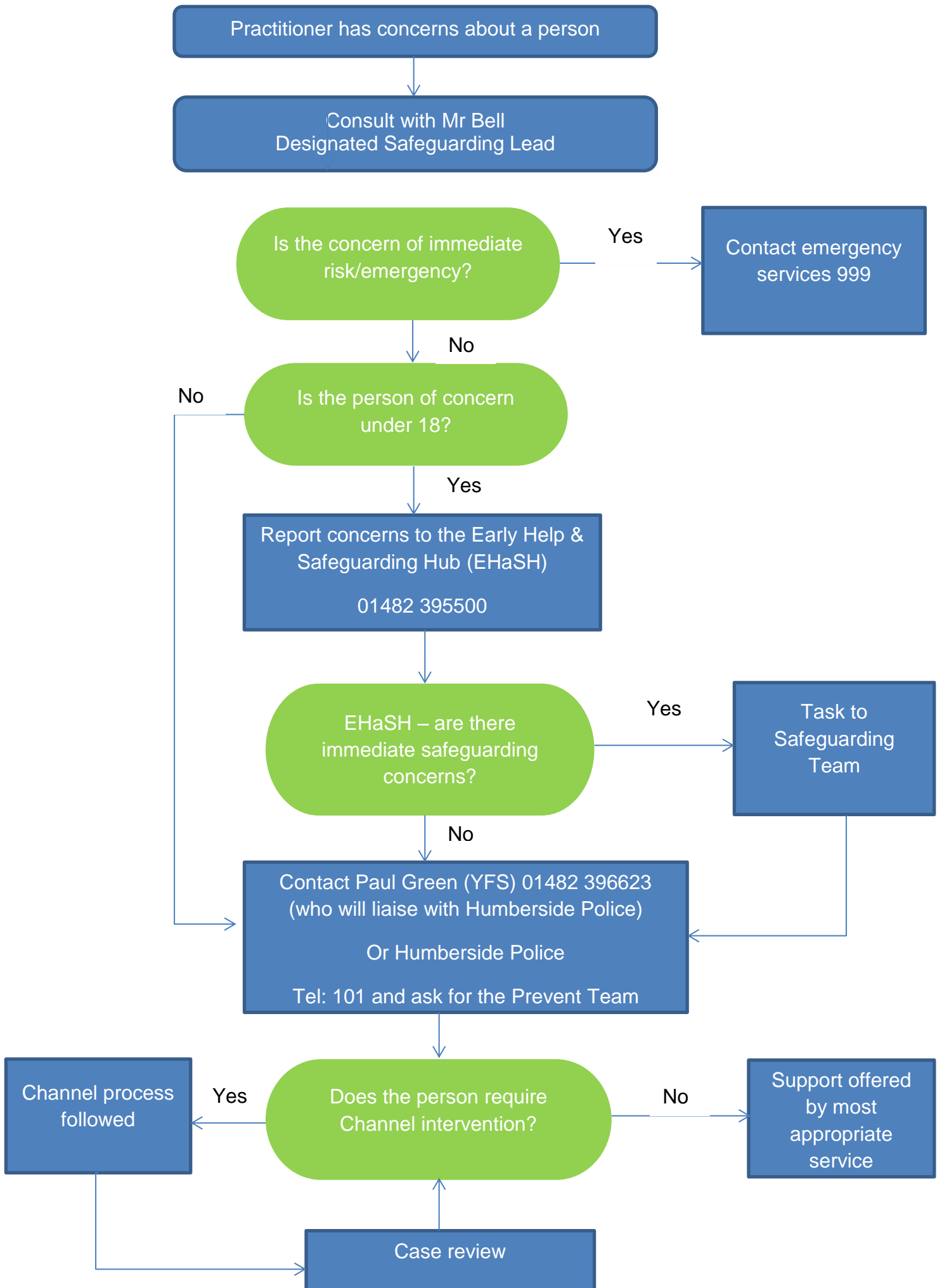


# Action to take if you have concerns that a person has or is being radicalised into extremist behaviour
